EYH Vaccination policy

In light of the current COVID-19 surge, vaccinations will be required for the 2022 conference. Vaccinations will be required for ALL attendees, of all ages. Booster shots are required for those eligible. Proof of vaccination MUST be provided at check in.

All attendees must be fully vaccinated two weeks prior to the conference date on March 12, 2022. Therefore all attendees must have received 2 doses of Pfizer-BioNTech (5+ years old) or Moderna (18+ years) or 1 dose of Johnson & Johnson's Janssen (18+ years) by **February 26**, **2022**.

Vaccine boosters: All attendees, volunteers, workshop leaders, and event coordinators (18+ years) must have received a booster shot if they are eligible prior to the conference: CDC booster eligibility guidelines. If you got the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, you're eligible for a booster five months after your last shot. If you got the Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine, you're eligible two months after you got the shot.

In-Person Agreement

The following agreement applies to all persons entering UC Berkeley campus on the day of the EYH conference, including attendees and guardians that are dropping off and picking up attendees.

I/we have not had any of these symptoms, which is new or not explained by a reason other than possibly having COVID-19: fever, chills, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, unusual weakness or fatigue, loss of taste or smell, muscle pain, headache, runny/congested nose, diarrhea, nausea/vomiting.

As I/we enter the UC Berkeley campus, I/we promise to abide by all policies, procedures, and protocols in place during the COVID-19 pandemic in accordance with the sheltering orders by Alameda County, City of Berkeley, State of California.

I'm/we're voluntarily coming to the EYH 2022 conference, and I/we agree to notify EYH at Berkeley immediately if I/we develop symptoms of COVID-19, receives a presumptive diagnosis of COVID-19, or tests positive for COVID-19 within 10 days of attending the conference.
